WITH a show noted as "rivalling the Pussycat Dolls", Claire Trentain is set to rock the Pig N Whistle tomorrow night.

And returning to the Sunshine Coast is a thrill for this sexy and captivating Queensland artist.

"I'm delighted to be back to promote the third single – What Would You Say? – from my album *Loving The Blue and Green*," Claire said.

"The album is really a self-portrait and I have drawn inspiration from my experiences of living and growing up in Queensland and travelling overseas. The songs are diverse, playful and personal."

The album has received rave reviews, including "excellent debut from Downunder" (Nelson Aspen, Channel 7 Sunrise), "every tune is quality" (Attitude, The Mercury) and "Claire Trentain's debut album

The second single off the album – Warmth – reached number two on the AIR charts (indie singles chart) and number 15 on the ARIA charts (Australasian singles chart).
