

Worldly debut album

HAMILTON singer songwriter Claire Trentain will launch her debut album, *Loving the Blue and Green*, at the Powerhouse on Tuesday night.

A blend of radio-friendly, guitar-based pop tunes inspired by years at high school, university and general life experience, Trentain said she was proud of the album she was given creative freedom to produce.

“There are three things I admire and aspire to in music – words, innovation and connection,” Trentain said.

“This album has come about in a much different way to most other albums. For me it has been a creative ‘work in progress’ that started way back when I was in high school.

“All the songs portray my experiences and feelings at different points in my life.”

With early interest from the UK and US, Trentain said she felt it was important to launch her career at home before venturing abroad.

“I had a vision of what my debut album would be and I worked on developing that dream,” she said.

“This album isn’t written for Australia, it’s written for the world.”

Loving the Blue and Green will be launched at the Powerhouse, New Farm on Tuesday at 8pm.
