Catchy pop tune soon to invade your brain space Provocative lyrics and a carousel-like melody are set to make Claire Trentain's new single **What Would You Say?** one of the catchiest pop tunes of the year.

Local Independent singer/songwriter Claire Trentain will officially launch her single at the Alhambra Lounge in Brisbane on Saturday 2 June coinciding with its release on iTunes.

Claire's inspiration for the lyrics of **What Would You Say?** came during her years at university. "The song is about having fun, being confident, knowing what you want and being open to trying new things," said Claire. The song's modern circus-like sound was inspired by 80s band Supertramp. In the song's playful video clip Claire, who has been described as Australia's next pop princess*, twirls her baton, teases a male pole dancer and plays with caged girls, representing an abstract screen play of her life.

"This film clip is all about not taking life too seriously," she said. Coming from Claire's debut album *Loving the Blue & Green* – the first Australian album to be produced by Swedish hit-makers Murlyn Music.

What Would You Say? is set to be your next mp3 player first track. Claire recently completed a successful regional tour of Queensland and will extend her international experience (having conquered Japan in 2006) when she joins dynamic Moroccan musicians Ganga Fusion at the Gnaoua and World Music festival of Essaouira, Morocco, in June.
